All students' wooden slats will be assembled into a complete picnic bench and all twenty six benches will be distributed around the school for the students to use. Students will be introduced to the artwork of Reinhard Schuldt, who makes ceramic insects. (Science – insect, information text link link). They will choose an insect to sketch focusing on shading. They will then transfer the sketch onto styrofoam to create a printing board. Using printing ink they will create clean prints. Students will use clay to create there chosen insect.
